INCLUSION CLINICS, held at The College of NJ (TCNJ), provide student-focused school-parent teams an opportunity to spend the day planning the details of inclusion for an individual child in a professionally led, relaxed atmosphere. *Teams MUST INCLUDE AT LEAST 3 people: one general educator, one parent (or family member) of the focus child, and one special educator. ANY TEAM THAT ARRIVES AT A CLINIC WITHOUT ONE OF THESE CRUCIAL MEMBERS WILL BE SENT HOME! (Schools may bring up to 5 additional professionals).

PLEASE NOTE: *With the permission of the parent, students in TCNJ's teacher education program may observe the Clinic, giving them a first-hand opportunity to experience research-based, collaborative planning for a child's placement in the general education classroom.*



CLINIC FACILITATORS: Each individual child's Clinic is facilitated by NJCIE Consultants and/or higher education faculty members with expertise in inclusive education.
